



## PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE

To encourage a sense of community, increase student safety and reduce distractions in the classroom, Nahunta Hall has a uniform dress code.

### Preschool and Kindergarten Everyday Uniform

#### Choice A

- Short sleeve polo shirt with school logo in **burgundy**
- Dress shorts or skirt in **navy**
- Solid short socks (covering the ankle) in **white**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**



#### Choice B

- Short or long sleeve polo shirt with school logo in **burgundy**
- Dress slacks in **navy**
- Solid socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy or black**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**

### Preschool and Kindergarten Dress Uniform

#### Choice A

- Oxford dress shirt in **white**
- Dress slacks in **navy**
- Pullover sweater vest or cardigan in **navy**
- Solid socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy or black**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**



#### Choice B

- Dress blouse with round collar in **white**
- Jumper in **navy**
- Optional cardigan in **navy**
- Solid tights or socks (covering the ankle or touching the knee) in **white**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**

## Dress Code Guidelines

### Footwear

Shoes must have an enclosed toe and heel. Good choices include Oxfords, Mary Janes and simple loafers. Moccasins are acceptable indoor shoes for students in the primary classroom. Primary students should be able to remove as well as fasten or tie their shoes independently.



Separate outdoor shoes or boots are required. Students should wear outdoor play shoes or boots to school and change into their classroom shoes after they arrive at school.

### Outerwear

Students must have an approved navy bucket hat or ball cap for sun protection during outdoor activities and a navy fleece jacket, cardigan, sweatshirt or hoodie for spring and fall activities held outdoors.

Students should bring outerwear for winter play including snowpants, boots, hats, gloves and coats.

Sweatshirts, fleece jackets, coats, boots and other outdoor clothing may not be worn inside the classrooms. A navy cardigan may be worn inside the classroom for extra warmth.

### Hair and Headwear

Hair must always be clean and neatly styled. Extreme hair colors or styles (such as Mohawks, partially shaved heads or brightly streaked tresses) are not allowed. Hair accessories may be worn if they are neutral (gold, silver, brown) or incorporate only the school colors of burgundy, white or navy. School plaid coordinated accessories are allowed.

Hats may not be worn inside the classrooms.

### General Guidelines

All students must have a full everyday uniform and a full dress uniform. Each preschool child must have a complete change of clothing, including underwear, which remains at school or in their backpack.

Undergarments must not be visible. If biking shorts are worn under skirts and jumpers (whether for warmth or personal modesty), they are considered an undergarment and must not be visible. Leggings are not allowed.

Students should bathe or shower daily. Clothing should be clean and in good repair. Clothing items may not be mixed and matched between grades or between casual and dressy uniforms.

Logoed polo shirts, sweater vests, jumpers, skirts, ties, blazers, headgear, fleece jackets, cardigans and PE clothes must be purchased through the school store.

## LOWER SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE

To encourage a sense of community, increase student safety and reduce distractions in the classroom, Nahunta Hall has a uniform dress code.

### Junior and Senior Elementary Everyday Uniform

#### Choice A

- Short sleeve polo shirt with school logo in **burgundy**
- Dress shorts or skirt in **navy**
- Solid short socks (covering the ankle) in **white**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**



#### Choice B

- Short or long sleeve polo shirt with school logo in **burgundy**
- Dress slacks in **navy**
- Solid socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy or black**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**

### Junior Elementary Dress Uniform

#### Choice A

- Oxford dress shirt (tucked in) in **white**
- Dress slacks in **navy**
- Conservative leather belt in **black or black**
- Solid tie in **burgundy**
- Pullover sweater vest or cardigan in **navy**
- Solid socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy or black**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**



#### Choice B

- Dress blouse with round collar in **white**
- Jumper in **school plaid**
- Crossover tie in **school plaid**
- Solid tights or socks (covering the ankle or touching the knee) in **white**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**

### Senior Elementary Dress Uniform

#### Choice A

- Oxford dress shirt (tucked in) in **white**
- Dress slacks in **navy**
- Conservative leather belt in **black or black**
- Solid tie in **burgundy**
- Solid socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy or black**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**



#### Choice B

- Dress blouse with round collar in **white**
- Skirt in **school plaid**
- Crossover tie **school plaid**
- Solid tights or socks (covering the ankle or touching the knee) in **white**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**

## **Dress Code Guidelines**

### **Footwear**

Shoes must have an enclosed toe and heel. Good choices include Oxfords, Mary Janes and simple loafers. Athletic shoes are appropriate only for P.E. class.

Separate outdoor shoes or boots are required. Students should wear outdoor play shoes or boots to school and change into their classroom shoes after they arrive at school.

Elementary students may bring a separate pair of athletic shoes for P.E. class



### **Outerwear**

Students must have an approved navy bucket hat or ball cap for sun protection during outdoor activities and a navy fleece jacket, cardigan, sweatshirt or hoodie for spring and fall activities held outdoors.

Students should bring outerwear for winter play including snowpants, boots, hats, gloves and coats.

Sweatshirts, fleece jackets, coats, boots and other outdoor clothing may not be worn inside the classrooms. A navy cardigan may be worn inside the classroom for extra warmth.

### **Hair and Headwear**

Hair must always be clean and neatly styled. Extreme hair colors or styles (such as Mohawks, partially shaved heads or brightly streaked tresses) are not allowed. Hair accessories may be worn if they are neutral (gold, silver, brown) or incorporate only the school colors of burgundy, white or navy. School plaid coordinated accessories are allowed.

## UPPER SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE

To encourage a sense of community, increase student safety and reduce distractions in the classroom, Nahunta Hall has a uniform dress code.

### Middle School and High School Everyday Uniform

#### Choice A

- Short sleeve polo shirt with school logo in **burgundy**
- Dress shorts or skirt in **charcoal**
- Solid short socks (covering the ankle) in **white**
- Dress shoes in **black**



#### Choice B

- Short or long sleeve polo shirt with school logo in **burgundy**
- Dress slacks in **charcoal**
- Solid socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy, black or charcoal**
- Dress shoes in **black, navy or brown**

### Middle School Dress Uniform

#### Choice A

- Dress shirt (tucked in) in **white**
- Dress slacks in **charcoal**
- Conservative leather belt in **black**
- Solid tie in **burgundy**
- Socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy, black or gray**
- Dress shoes in **black**



#### Choice B

- Dress blouse with a collar in **white**
- Skirt in **charcoal**
- Tie in **school plaid**
- Optional pantyhose in **skin tones** (white, cream, nude, beige, chocolate, black)
- Dress shoes in **black**

### High School Dress Uniform

#### Choice A

- Dress shirt (tucked in) in **white**
- Dress slacks in **charcoal**
- Conservative leather belt in **black**
- Solid tie in **burgundy**
- Blazer in **navy**
- Socks (rising three inches above the ankle) in **navy, black or gray**
- Dress shoes in **black**



#### Choice B

- Dress blouse with a collar in **white**
- Skirt in **charcoal**
- Tie in **school plaid**
- Blazer in **navy**
- Optional pantyhose in **skin tones** (white, cream, nude, beige, chocolate, black)
- Dress shoes in **black**

## Dress Code Guidelines

### Footwear

Shoes must have an enclosed toe and heel. Good choices include Oxfords, Mary Janes and simple loafers. Middle school and high school students may also wear dress boots with skirts. Heel height should be less than two inches. Athletic shoes are appropriate only for P.E. class.



### Outerwear

Students must have an approved navy bucket hat or ball cap for sun protection during outdoor activities and a navy fleece jacket, cardigan, sweatshirt or hoodie for spring and fall activities held outdoors.

Sweatshirts, fleece jackets, coats, boots and other outdoor clothing may not be worn inside the classrooms. A navy cardigan may be worn inside the classroom for extra warmth with all uniform options except the high school dress options that require a blazer.

### Hair and Headwear

Hair must always be clean and neatly styled. Extreme hair colors or styles (such as Mohawks, partially shaved heads or brightly streaked tresses) are not allowed. Hair accessories may be worn if they are neutral (gold, silver, brown) or incorporate only the school colors of burgundy, white or navy. School plaid coordinated accessories are allowed.

Hats may not be worn inside the classrooms.

### General Guidelines

All students must have a full everyday uniform and a full dress uniform.

Undergarments must not be visible. If biking shorts are worn under skirts and jumpers (whether for warmth or personal modesty), they are considered an undergarment and must not be visible. Leggings are not allowed.

Students should bathe or shower daily. Noticeable perfume or cologne should be avoided. Students in middle school and high school may wear natural looking makeup. Clothing should be clean and in good repair. Clothing items may not be mixed and matched between grades or between casual and dressy uniforms.

Pants should fit properly, resting on the waist or hips. Pant legs must not be rolled or pegged to alter the length of the pant leg. The bottom opening of the pant leg should not be elastic.

Logoed polo shirts, sweater vests, jumpers, skirts, ties, blazers, headgear, fleece jackets, cardigans and PE clothes must be purchased through the school store.

For farm work and outdoor community service, students may wear dark blue jeans that are in good repair with the burgundy polo shirt. Students may wear athletic shoes or work boots that meet all other requirements.
